This scholarship is open only to junior year or higher students, which includes graduate school. The applicant must complete the attached application and submit a one-page essay discussing the topic entitled "Infrastructure Improvements – How Technology will Influence the move to Connected Vehicles".

CRITERIA:

The following criteria will be used to award the scholarships to applicants: academic performance, awards and honors, extracurricular involvement, work experience and the written essay. Please use some sort of digital word format for the essay....no handwritten copies. No plagiarism will be allowed. If sources are used, they must be notated. The academic committee will select up to five (5) successful applicants following receipt of all applications based on the above deadline.
